

Privacy Policy

The **Christian Counselors of Texas, Inc.** (hereinafter CCT or CCTX.org) seeks to respect and protect the privacy of our clients, donors, volunteers and other customers. CCT does not share email addresses or other personal information supplied on a web form, via an email message, or provided to us offline to any outside organizations for any reason other than to process credit card information, complete a registration or to comply with the law. Personal information will not be sold or given to third parties nor will we send mailings on behalf of other organizations, without your specific agreement to do so, as in the case of our conference exhibitors.

Similar information may be submitted to us on an order form or registration form. All credit card processing is handled through Affinipay Corporation (affinipay.com).

Membership or Conference Registrants Lists. Membership list is not for sale. When you visit our website or become a member, your name, mailing information, phone number and email address will not be sold.

Security. Our site has industry standard security measures in place to protect the loss, misuse and alteration of the information under our control.
